7. Placements of B.Tech. 2024 Passed out Batch

The GB members applauded the placements success of B.Tech. 2024 passed out batch students. The total number of offers is 557. Unique Placements 431, where the number of companies that conducted campus placements is 76. The highest package is 24 LPA and the average package 4.64 LPA. The students got 60 paid internships, where the highest paid internship is with a stipend of Rs. 1,10,000/- per month.
